The Museum of Ventura County announces the BONITA C. MCFARLAND SCHOLARSHIPS, 2019

For High School Seniors and College-Level Students of the Visual Arts

<u>Eligibility</u>

The Bonita C. McFarland Scholarships are available to any high school senior or college level student of the visual arts who is also a Ventura County resident.

Amount of the Awards

The total amount awarded will be \$4000.00. In past years, individual awards have been \$500 or more, depending on need and number of scholarships given.

Selection Process

Applicants will be selected by a committee consisting of members of the Museum's Fine Arts Committee.

<u>Criteria</u>

Awards will be based on artistic merit and commitment as demonstrated by the application, letter of recommendation, and examples of work.

<u>Timeline</u>

Applications due postmarked by: June 25, 2019, or delivered in person to the Museum no later than Tuesday, June 25, 2019, at 5:00 pm. Awards Reception in July at the Museum at 100 E. Main Street, Ventura, CA 93001

Please submit up to 10 reproductions of examples of your work. Photographs, computer printouts, color copies, or black and white copies (for black and white work), will be accepted. Do not send original artwork. Label all images with your name, title of work, medium, and date of work. Materials will not be returned.

B) Letter of Recommendation

All applicants must have a letter of recommendation from a teacher (or other individual with whom they have worked) sent directly to the museum. This letter is confidential and cannot be returned. Letter of recommendation should:

1. Describe the relationship with the applicant; 2. Describe the abilities and talents of the applicant; 3. Assess the potential of the applicant for continued work in the field.

Letter should be sent directly to the Museum, not to the applicant.

Personal Essay

Please submit five copies of a typewritten essay (up to 250 words) describing your qualifications. You might wish to discuss (but are not limited to) the following topics:

- 1. What type of art do you practice, and why?
- 2. Why do you wish to continue your art studies?
- 3. What are your career and educational goals?
- 4. What are your past achievements in the arts?
