Making the GRADE

How MVC school tours brought history and culture to life for one teacher's classroom

Meet Stacy Mikkelson 2023-2024 Teacher of Distinction

A third-grade teacher at Pierpont Elementary in Ventura, Stacy has been inspiring students for 26 years. This is her story, which she shared at the History and Horizons Harvest Luncheon held on April 6, 2024 at MVC's Agriculture Museum in Santa Paula.



I teach young minds because I understand that **small moments can make a big impact on young people** who are just learning how to navigate the world. I have been taking my third graders to the museum for many years because it is such a rich experience.

During the month of November, I teach my students the lessons and impact of Native American communities across the United States, specifically the Chumash of Ventura County. My throughline is 'where you live determines how you live'.

At the end of the month, **I schedule our field trip to MVC and WOW, does it come alive for them then!** My students are so excited to see what they have been studying and really experience it! Experience is the key to success with young learners.

My students come away with a grand appreciation for Chumash culture and their own culture. They see that this isn't just A museum, but THEIR museum.

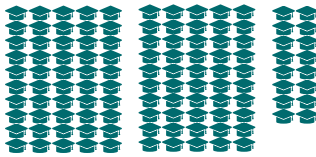
One student I taught, a few years ago, had a profound experience with this type of hands-on education. Every student learns differently, and this student had trouble relating to the material, went off task, and didn't want to do the reading. It wasn't until we visited the Museum that the switch flipped. They began to see themselves in this history and understand the material by relating it to their own lives. Today, they are in 9th grade at Ventura High School. **They kept that understanding with them and now they want to go to college for history!**

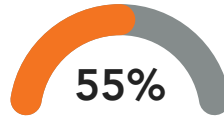

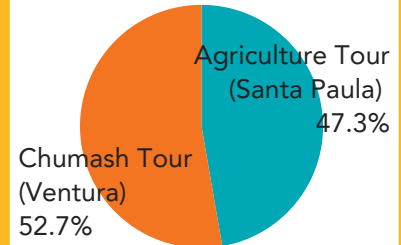

Research Library & Archives Intern Ali Phelps worked with MVC Library staff to process backlogged collections.

During her internship, Ali processed 17.27 cubic feet of material. That volume would fill a medium-sized refrigerator!



Ali worked with the Malinda Chouinard papers and Vetco Offshore Industry records and created finding aids for 16 archival collections.

After Ali's internship, she graduated with a Master's degree in Library and Information Science from San Jose State University and **accepted a position with the National Parks Service History Collection.**



My experience at the Library provided a solid foundation in archival skills. Without this experience [...] I would not be ready to embark on this next adventure.

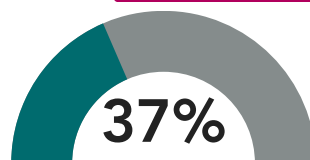

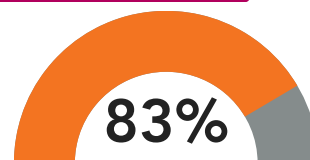

EMPOWERING STUDENT ARTISTS

IN 2024, MVC AWARDED \$11,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS TO TALENTED ART STUDENTS ACROSS THE COUNTY.

The Museum of Ventura County is championing the transformative power of art through its Bonita C. McFarland Visual Arts Scholarship. The scholarship, supported by the generous endowment of the late Bonita C. McFarland, and administered by the Museum of Ventura County and its Fine Arts Committee, **goes beyond funding education—it amplifies emerging artistic voices and enriches our community.**

The candidates for this scholarship are **promising high school seniors and continuing college students in visual arts who reside in the County.** They are chosen for their artistic merit and dedication, demonstrated through a portfolio, an essay on their artistic and career aspirations, a recommendation letter from a mentor, and their educational achievements.

For the 2024 scholarship cycle, students' career aspirations ranged from more traditional careers such as making and teaching art, to art therapy, animation, film storyboarding, character and set design, concept art, illustration, and architectural design.

It's more than a scholarship. It's about empowering the artists of tomorrow, while creating a brighter, more colorful future for Ventura County.

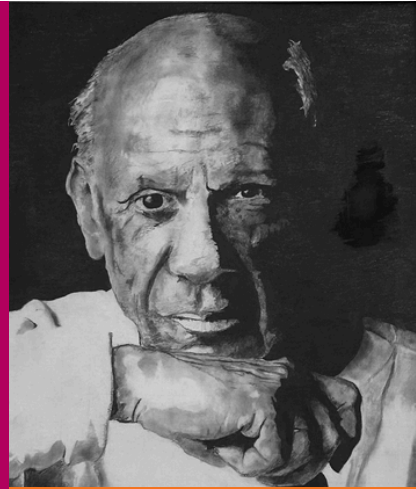

The 150th Anniversary of Ventura County

In 2023, Ventura County officially turned 150 years old. This was an opportunity to build community connection and pride in our region's unique history as we move forward together into a brighter future.

MINI-GRANT PROGRAM

To support community celebration, the County of Ventura and Museum of Ventura County co-created a grant program that made a total of \$40,000 available to individuals and local organizations. Stipends ranged from \$300-\$1,700 to participate in the Mountains to Sea Jubilee, in pop-up experiences across the County, and to brand their individual programs as part of the 150th Anniversary.
